1. Aims and objectives:

- set appropriate and challenging targets for EAL pupils;
- review targets regularly;
- monitor the effectiveness of the individual pupil EAL plans periodically;
- assist in the collection of EAL data;
- implement the school's equalities policy and schemes;
- report and deal with all incidents of discrimination;
